



**Lancashire Aero Club, Centenary Celebration

City Airport Manchester (Barton)**

The Lancashire Aero Club is the oldest established flying club in the Country whose mission statement is to promote aviation.

The Club was formed in 1922 and initially used an Aerodrome at the Alexandra Park in Manchester. In 1925 the Aero Club moved to Woodford. At the start of WWII it arrived at Barton. In July 2009 the Club moved to Kenyon Hall Airfield near Warrington but it has retained close links with Barton and Woodford.

The Lancashire Aero Club is 100 years old in June 2022 and we are hosting a Fly-in at the City Airport Manchester.

The event is open to all GA aircraft, including microlights and gyrocopters. We want to encourage as many vintage aircraft as possible to fly-in for the event.

There will be a party with music and food on the Saturday Evening for Visitors who have flown in and Lancashire Aero Club Members and Guests.

We have negotiated reduced landing fees and overnight parking for the event.

On the Sunday our formal event will start at 13.30 with a presentation of Plaques and Awards and a Fly Past by an Avro Anson Aircraft.

To support the event, we will have an exhibition of Vintage Cars and Bikes and many interesting exhibits from the Woodford Heritage Museum, including the famous bouncing Bomb.

Visitors and members of the public will be able to enjoy a guided airside tour by The Friends of Barton Club Members.
